Form of Notice for advertising your proposals

Frensham Great Pond and COMMON

Waverley Borough Council has applied to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for consent under section 38 of the Commons Act 2006/section 23 of the National Trust Act 1971 to carry out restricted works on Frensham Common. The Planning Inspectorate will decide the application on behalf of the Secretary of State.

The proposed works are: (1) Construction of replacement Visitor Centre (the Heathland Hub) with café, toilets, Ranger Office, workshop, staff shower, classroom/meeting room, storage of 249.54 SQM plus additional 20.8m of fencing for security to rangers work yard. (2) Car park reconfiguration with an additional 15 car park spaces of 17266 SQM (3) Two new wildlife ponds for Natterjack Toad conservation of 78.54 square metres each.

The works will be located on and adjacent to the existing footprint of the current building and car park located adjacent to the Great Pond off Bacon Lane, closest post code GU10 2QB but shared with the Frensham Pond Hotel.
